SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

Summary

Implementing House Bills (HB) 246, 414, and 794 and Senate Bill (SB) 456

Reason for Supplemental Notice

On October 10, 2025, the Board of Pharmacy (agency) published MAR Notice No. 2025-174.1 regarding the public hearing on the proposed changes to the agency's rules, in the 2025 Montana Administrative Register, Issue No. 19.

A clerical error, however, was discovered in the numbering of the notice. MAR Notice No. 2025-174.1 should have been numbered MAR Notice No. 2025-206.1. This notice is correcting that error. There have been no changes to the proposed rulemaking other than the number of the notice being corrected.
